Loki's Multiversal Empire

## I. Committee Background

The Marvel and DC Multiversal Committee was formed by Doctor Strange (Earth-19999) after catastrophic events caused by The Scarlet Witch (Wanda Maximoff). Wanda's grief over losing her children led her to use the Darkhold, a powerful book of dark magic, which gave her the ability to manipulate reality and travel between universes. However, the Darkhold's corrupting power consumed her, making her believe that the only way to reunite with her children was by forcibly traveling across the multiverse.

To achieve infinite freedom of travel between universes, Wanda needed the help of America Chavez, a young girl with the ability to cross dimensions. However, America was unable to fully control her powers, making her an unwitting tool in Wanda's reckless pursuit of her goal. This desperate quest caused widespread destruction, killing numerous individuals and threatening multiple timelines, creating a multiversal catastrophe.

This devastation was the primary reason for the formation of the committee, but it was also a kind of Spider-Man who visited Doctor Strange to warn him briefly about the dangers of the multiverse and the consequences these could have. Initially, Stephen dismissed him as a lunatic seeking attention. But the conversation haunted Strange, who couldn't shake the feeling that there was more to the warning than he had realized.

After the catastrophic events caused by the Scarlet Witch, Doctor Strange (Earth-19999) began assembling the Marvel & DC Committee to prevent



further multiversal chaos. Determined to keep things from spiraling out of control, he gathered some of the greatest minds and most powerful heroes from countless universes, all united by common goals. Together, they defined the committee's main purpose: to preserve the timelines, essential for the survival of millions, and to prevent catastrophic events like universes colliding or entire realities being destroyed due to wrong decisions or emerging threats. Their goal was to maintain balance in the multiverse, ensuring that every universe had protection from multiversal challenges.

Some of the committee's greatest achievements are:

- The Devourer of Worlds' Rampage (Marvel Universe): Galactus and his herald grew stronger by consuming worlds with advanced civilizations. This allowed him to travel between universes. Heroes intervened before his rampage escalated.

- Darkseid's Universe-Threatening Mistake (Earth-55, DC Universe): Darkseid created a techno-organic virus within Cyborg, which spread to Earth. The virus infected anyone in contact with technology. The MARVEL & DC Committee contained the outbreak before it spread further.

# II. Topic Information

### a. History of the Topic

#### c. Bloc Positions

- Doctor Strange (Earth-199999): While studying the ancient arts of magic,
  Doctor Strange was called upon by Loki the Guardian of the Multiverse for
  help. Upon witnessing the magnitude of the multiversal crisis unleashed by
  Wanda's actions, he realized that this battle would determine the fate of the
  multiverse. He became convinced that the outcome of this conflict would
  either save or irreparably destroy the fabric of reality itself.
- Iron Man (Earth-400): His universe was one of the affected ones, and now
  he, along with other heroes, is fighting to protect it. His story follows the
  events up to Avengers: Endgame, with one crucial difference, he survived
  after using the Infinity Gauntlet.
- Captain America (Earth-400): Captain America was called upon alongside
  Iron Man to join the fight. True to his heroic values, he is determined to
  protect the multiverse from collapsing, knowing the stakes are higher than
  ever. His history follows the events up to Avengers: Endgame, where he
  returned the stones, but unlike his original timeline, he chose not to stay in
  the past with Peggy and instead continued to serve as a protector of the
  multiverse.
- Wally West (Earth -1): Wally West, a speedster from the DC universe, was chasing one of his enemies through the city when his world collided with another. Knowing he has to protect his loved ones and city, Wally joins the fight to stop the multiverse from falling apart. His speed and drive make him an important part of the battle.
- Superboy (Earth-0): He was hanging out with other young heroes when suddenly, thousands of screams echoed from the streets. Looking out, he saw the horrifying sight of his world colliding with others, and villains flooding the streets. Remembering what his father would have wanted, Superboy knew he had to join the fight alongside other unknown heroes to protect the city.



- Wolverine and Deadpool (Earth-10005): While carrying out some "heroic" deeds, their world suddenly shook violently. They immediately realized something was wrong. Turning their heads, they saw wave after wave of unknown people being thrown into their universe. With their past experience in dealing with chaotic events, they knew they had to join the fight to stop another attempt to destroy their world.
- Scarlet Witch (Earth-400): After breaking free from the Darkhold (in this universe, her death never occurred), Wanda became a new and better person and hero. She redeemed herself following the events of WandaVision. One day, while at the Avengers HQ, a sudden wormhole pulled her out of her universe and into another. Realizing what was happening, she quickly understood the gravity of the situation and joined forces with the Avengers she encountered in this new universe.
- Thor (Earth-199999): After taking a break from past events, Thor was caught

- Miss Martian (Earth-16): While fighting Brainiac, Miss Martian's world collided with another universe.
